KINDERGARTEN

No other supplies needed (please see teacher for itemized list if you choose to purchase supplies elsewhere)

- 1 box of Kleenex or disinfecting wipes
- FULL SIZE BACKPACK – NO WHEELS

GRADE ONE

- \$14.00 for school to provide classroom supplies (folders, pens and watercolor paints, etc.) and headphones (students keep at end of year) Separate check payable to Elm Creek School. PLEASE LABEL ITEMS.
- School box – plastic (approx. 8x5)
- 12 or more **sharpened #2** pencils (yellow wood case)
- 3 (4 oz.) bottles White **ELMER'S** school glue
- 3 glue sticks
- 2 boxes **CRAYOLA** crayons (24 count)
- 1 box colored pencils (24 count)
- 1 child's Fiskar's-brand scissors (metal blades, pointed tip)

- 2 composition wide rule notebooks
- 2 glue sticks **and** 1 bottle Elmer's white glue
- 2 boxes of Kleenex
- 4 low-odor dry erase markers
- 1 container of disinfecting wipes
- 1 box colored pencils, sharpened
